# Principal's Corner

This past week our students have been learning about Red Ribbon Week; what it means and the history behind it. I would like to share with you the history of how Red Ribbon Week began.

Red Ribbon Week came into existence because of a man named Enrique (Kiki) Camarena who grew up in a dirt-floored house with hopes of making a difference. Camarena worked his way through college, served in the Marines, became a police officer and decided to join the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.

Camarena was sent to Mexico to investigate a major drug cartel. One day, as he was leaving the office to meet his wife for lunch, five men appeared alongside of him and shoved him into a car. One month later, Camarena's body was found in a shallow grave. He had been tortured to death.

In honor of Camarena's memory and his battle against illegal drugs, friends and neighbors began to wear red badges of satin. A coalition was formed as a result and red ribbons came to symbolize Camarena's memory and his fight against drugs.

The National Family Partnership organized the first Nationwide Red Ribbon Campaign in 1988. Since that time, the campaign has reached millions of U.S. children.




